Botta Sferazza Architects took on the task of transforming this structure, which began life as a simple Bridgehampton barn in the 1700s, into a modern home. The clients had a long list of musts: preserve a large beech tree on the property, transform the barn into a giant great room with new living wings on both sides, and remake an 18th-century cottage into a two-bedroom guest residence. Part of the transformation involved removing the barn's original hay loft and replacing the rear portion with a glass curtain wall, thus establishing a relationship between indoors and out—and embracing views of the cherished beech tree. “Barn timbers? Modern windows? Yes! It works. I could live here!” raves judge Jennifer Mabley.
